diakonos/servant, diakonia/service, diakoneō/to serve



What Elders & Deacons Do

• Elders

- flock with divisive false teaching (Acts 20:28) this authority is in the Lord (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13) doing so as examples in Godly conduct (Hebrews 13:7)

- Protect the sheep from those who would damage the Have charge over the flock, but not as overlords since Instruct the body in Biblical truth (1 Timothy 5:17) Lead the body in God's direction and obedient practice,



What Elders & Deacons Do

• Elders

- Pray for the body and its members, including oil (James 5:14-16)
- and eagerly (1 Peter 5:1-5)

 Keep watch over the souls of the people in their charge to ultimately give an account to God (Hebrews 13:17) particularly those who are sick and anointing them with
