Go Forward

Know: We clearly see two things from Scripture about the glorious doctrine of unconditional election. First, we are to know about it (since God reveals it to us in His Word). Second, though, it's too much for us to know or understand fully. Ultimately, both of these truths push us to the glory of God. When we know more about His ways it reveals His glory. And what we see that we cannot understand just reminds us that He is not finite like us, but grand and glorious and great!

Grow: Take some time to think about any objections or problems you have with the doctrine of election. What are they? Why do you have them? Once you have your list, read Romans 9:6-33. See if you can find your objections/problems in that passage. Also, see how God responds - and calls us to respond - to those objections/problems.

Show: In light of the fact that God chooses whom will be saved for eternal life with Him, take a look at the following verses: John 15:16; Ephesians 1:3-4; 1 Thessalonians 1:2-10; 2 Peter 1:2-11. Pay close attention to God's "cause and effect" in our lives. Specifically, if He has chosen you to be saved, what difference does that make in the way you live your life according to these verses? What does your life look like right now compared to what you read in these verses? Why? Seek God's wisdom about how to address any differences. What one thing is He leading you to stop/start/change?
