Once you have those names in mind, begin asking God to provide you with opportunities to engage in conversation that will give you a platform from which to share it. Know that this is usually a process, and it might take many interactions before you can get to a point to share your testimony. That's okay. It's not your job to save these people anyway! It's God's job! Your job is simply to be faithful and available, and to open your mouth in His strength when that moment comes!
