- 4. Are you linked to a small group within your home church? (Describe the linkage.)
- 5. When you return to the U.S., is your home church the center of your activities (What kind of connection do you have to your home church when you're home?)
- 6. Has anyone from your home church visited you in your place of ministry? Is this something that would benefit you?
- 7. Has anyone from your sending agency visited you in your place of ministry?
- 8. Does your sending agency have a 'member care' connection with you where you can communicate needs, concerns, counsel, direction, etc?
 - How often do you report to your sending agency in a 'member care' accountability relationship
 - How is this accomplished?
 - How good a job does your sending agency do in the area of member care?
 - How good a job does your local church do in the area of member care?
 - If you could design it, what would your own member care network look life, and how would it function?
