Who can attend this mission experience?

This experience is open to any collegeaged adult [18-25] who faithfully attends our church worship services or is part of our college community.

How will I pay for this?

The \$50 deposit is non-refundable and starts your fundraising process. There will be two fundraisers you can participate in come January & February as well as writing personal letters to families and friends to help pay for your expenses.

How will we get there?

We will travel together in 15 passenger vans and use them for transportation throughout our week.

Where will we stay?

We will eat, sleep, shower, and worship, at the SOS building located at 2505 Poplar Avenue, in the Binghampton neighborhood of Memphis.

What do we bring?

You need to bring bedding (a sleeping bag or twin sheets), pillow, work clothes, work gloves, water bottle, and personal items. As for tools and construction materials, SOS will provide everything our group will need. Therefore, you do not need to bring any of your own tools. A complete list of what to bring will be emailed to you after your registration is received. NO CELLS PHONES will be allowed on this trip.

What do we do at night?

During the evenings there will be a program that is filled with worship and a Christ-centered message. We want each participant to hear a call to love and serve our risen Lord Jesus Christ.

There is free time to hang out with our group or other groups at the SOS Building after chapel each evening. Wednesday afternoon and evening is free for our group to enjoy the city.
