Elements of Global Member Care

Communication

- Staying in touch through email/phone calls
- Sharing Church news and other things on the home front
- Sending Birthday/holiday cards
- Skype with Workers during L2L meetings, prayer groups, parties, etc.
- Sharing our prayer requests with them

Transition and trauma care

- Provide debriefing
- Counseling Services
- Recovery Retreats
- Personal visits for comfort while home
- Prayer Support

Caring for visiting Workers

- Arrange lodging, transportation, etc.
- Host prayer meetings
- Host luncheons or small groups to hear reports from Workers
- Arrange play dates with kiddos
- o Invite Workers to your Bible studies, social groups, coffee, etc.

Send care packages

- Load boxes with goodies just for fun, or birthdays/holidays, etc.
- Items requested by Workers
- o Cards and photos from the church body
- Holiday decorations

Global Member Care trips to visit Workers

- Overnight trips on weekends to visit those within driving distance.
- > Longer trips overseas or to those not within driving distance

1.Prayer and Encouragement

- Spend strategic time in prayer with them. Meet those they are praying for. Hear the requests they can't put in newsletters.
- See what daily life and ministry is like.
- Go to church with them.
- Prayer counseling
- Love on them!

2.Counsel and Pastoral Care

- Debrief difficult situations
- Talk through team issues, marriage issues, etc.

Missions Prayer Team

- Meet monthly to pray for Workers' prayer requests
- o Receive Workers' newsletters and prayer requests via email
- o Communicate with Workers to let them know we prayed for them each month
- Special prayer meetings when Workers are in town to engage with and pray for them personally
