# FINANCIAL STATEMENT

I understand that my student is responsible for raising 100% of the funds required for the Mission Experience. The money he/she raises covers travel cost, food, lodging, ministry expense and on ground transportation.

Financial donations made to any Mission Experiences accounts are not my student's— they belong to God and have been given to Fellowship Bible Church in order to accomplish the mission and work of the church.

If, for some reason, my student does not ultimately participate in the Mission Experience to which he/she has been accepted, I am responsible for any fees incurred as a result of my cancellation.

If my student does not raise enough money to pay for the Mission Experience, he/she may not be able to go. Any money raised will be applied to the current Mission Experience or materials needed.

If my student raises an amount of money that exceeds his/her needs, the remaining money will be dispersed to other team members in need or used by Fellowship Bible Church for other financial needs associated with the Mission.

If, for some reason, my student does not participate on the Mission Experience to which he/she has been accepted, I understand that the money donated to his/her Mission Experience **cannot be refunded to my student or to the donors** due to the non-profit status of Fellowship Bible Church.

In order to comply with the IRS, all checks for support of my student's Mission Experience must be made out to **Fellowship Bible Church**. Donors should **write the student's name and "jH Mission Experience" in the memo line of their check**.

If inappropriate behavior and/or the breaking of any team covenant or policies causes my student to be sent home early from my Mission Experience as a disciplinary action, none of the money raised will be refunded to my student or any donors.

If any inappropriate behavior and/or breaking of any team covenant policies occur, my student will be sent home at my expense.
