#### **FIRST DAY(S) OF SCHOOL**

To make your child's transition as easy as possible, here are a few suggestions:

\*Speak positively to your child about the fun he/she will have at school. (Your child will sense your excitement or your nervousness.)

\*Tell your child good-bye at the door and let him/her enter the room with the teacher at the door.

\*Please do not enter the classroom with your child. From years of experience we have learned that saying good-bye at the door and making the separation quickly is the best way to help your child adjust. Prolonging the inevitable separation only makes it more difficult.

You may observe your child's class at any time with a staff escort, but we ask that you do so through the window in the door once the whole class has signed in. This is less distracting to the class and you will see a truer picture of how your child is adjusting.

## **TUITION SCHEDULE**

If your child is currently enrolled you have already paid September tuition. **October tuition is now due**. November tuition will be due at the beginning of October, etc.

You should have received a tuition invoice from your child's teachers, with directions for paying online. We are very excited to once again offer this service.

If you choose to write a check instead, make it out to **FBC** and include your child's name in the memo line. Please drop the check in the mail slot of the ABC office door (just around the corner from Room 115b).
